

MTC's intensive program is tailored for Flagship students to enhance proficiency in all aspects of Chinese language in a condensed time period within 8 weeks.

Program Description

The 8 weeks program includes 20 hours of Intensive Language Training per week, Monday through Friday. The daily schedule alternates between Class Lectures and Drill Classes to enhance and maximize language learning. 1-1 Personalized Training is included daily to cater to student needs.

For an immersive experience, the program also includes educational experiences such as cultural excursions, cultural classes, professional seminars, company visits, local lunch outings, and language partner activities.

Our courses and activities are primarily conducted in Chinese, and the design of our program requires students to be proactive and take the initiative to participate in all activities.



We are committed to provide a proficiency-based learning environment for Flagship students to achieve the goal of enhancing Chinese language proficiency and cultivating cultural competence.



Curriculum Design

Courses are offered from intermediate-high to advanced levels and are taught by professional instructors.

All materials are presented in both traditional and simplified Chinese. Students may choose either traditional or simplified Chinese for their homework and tests.



Co-Curricular & Extracurricular Activities

MTC enforces immersive learning and cultural understanding by providing 48 hours of various activities for the 8 weeks program.

Co-Curricular Activities features Language Practicum and Cultural Immersion by including cultural classes, field trips, professional guest seminars, and company visits. (ex: Chinese culinary, National Palace Museum, Tea Appreciation, etc.)

Extracurricular Activities features practical application of Chinese through lunch outing activities and language partner activities. (ex: night markets, local food experience, short hiking or outing trips,











Placement Testing

On the first day of program, all students are required to take an Online Oral Assessment Test. Students' class placements will be determined by the comprehensive assessment of Online Reading and Listening Assessment Test and Online Oral Assessment Test.

Transcript, Credit, and Grade Equivalencies

The grades on MTC's transcript will use a percentage grading system. The grade equivalency and credit transfer will be determined by student's home institution.

After successfully completing the program, and with the concerns of COVID-19 and relevant border control measures, MTC will email an official scanned copy of transcript to the student. The average processing time is 2-3 weeks.

COVID-19 Quarantine Policy and the Relevant Costs

In response to COVID-19, Taiwan CDC has announced that anyone entering Taiwan from overseas is required to undertake **14 days** of mandatory supervised quarantine (the 14 days of quarantine is counted from the day after arriving, so the actual quarantine period is 15 days) at a designated qualified hotel.

Program participants are required to follow this protocol and pay for the quarantine period:

- The cost of the quarantine hotel. The room rate ranges from USD70-170 per person per day. All room rates include daily meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
- 2. The transportation fees, approx. USD70-170 per person.
- 3. Other possible medical related costs (there could be other costs associated with testing after the quarantine).

*Please note:

- I. MTC follows Taiwan CDC's prevention policy and regulations. We will update the CDC's latest changes of policy and regulations via email and/or website announcement.
- II. The cost of the quarantine hotel must be paid in full upon booking to confirm the reservation.
- III. The participants are required to arrive in Taiwan on Friday, June 18 (Taiwan Time), and to undertake 14 days of quarantine from June 19-July 2 and 7 days of self-health management from July 3-July 9.

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General Q&A

Q1: What does tuition fee cover?

A1: The fee includes language classes, textbooks, handouts, field trips, culture classes, guest seminar, and accident insurance.

Q2: What does tuition fee **NOT** cover?

A2: The fee excludes international airfare, housing, daily meals, and the costs (meals, tickets, and transportation) of local lunch outing Activity and Language Partner Activity, and the relevant costs of COVID-19 quarantine.

Q3: How much does rent and living cost in Taipei?

A3: The rents for individual rooms in Taipei are around USD450-750 per month. For additional living costs, students are expected to prepare approximately USD300-500 a month for daily meals, transportation, and other personal expenses.

Q4: Will there be a class suitable for my proficiency level?

A4: Prior to arrival, MTC will send you an email notice of Online Reading and Listening Assessment Test. The test is required to be completed by Saturday, April 10 (Taiwan Time). On the first day of program, all students are required to take an Online Oral Assessment Test. Students' class placements will be determined by the comprehensive assessment of Online Reading and Listening Assessment Test and Online Oral Assessment Test. These assessment will help place students in the most suitable class level.

Q5: Is there a limit of students allowed to join the program?

A5: The minimum program size is 25 students, if the final student number registered in the program is below 25, the program will be cancelled. If the program is canceled due to low enrollment or other uncontrollable factors, MTC will notify the participants via email and/or website announcement and refund the whole tuition fee (including the non-refundable Enrollment Deposit) to the participants.

Q6: What is the refund policy?

A6: The deposit is NOT refundable.

The tuition fee refund policy follows the NTNU policy:

90% of tuition will be refunded for applications submitted no later than the day before the program starts.

50% will be refunded for applications submitted before 1/3 of the program is completed. 0% refunds will be given for applications submitted after the semester is 1/3 completed.Q7:

Q7: How do I prepare for the online class during the quarantine period?

A7: MTC uses Zoom for online classes and will email students the account information before the program start date. Students are required to bring a laptop from the U.S. for the online classes.
